Campers are encouraged to try new things, experience the outdoors, find meaningful success, and return year after year to strengthen relationships, life skills, and well-being in a culture of joy and acceptance.

Same-grade campers live as a cabin family and participate in activities that include teambuilding, campfires, family-style meals, camp-wide events, and daily reflection.

Traditional Campers are entering 5th-7th grade and participate in a wide-variety of activities:

-  **Creative Arts:** Visual Arts, Jewelry, Pottery, Crafts, Theater
-  **Calm Down!:** Crafts, Literacy, Meditation, Movement, Yoga
-  **Nature:** Outdoor Adventures, Hiking, Water, Wildlife
-  **Ropes Course (R.O.C.K.):** Teambuilding, Climbing Tower
-  **Sports & Games:** Archery, Biking, Field and Court Sports
-  **Waterfront:** Swimming, Canoeing, Kayaking, Paddleboarding

Bridge Campers are entering 8th & 9th grade and can choose from the following:

-  **Sampler:** A blending of all of our Bridge Programs with arts and crafts, sports and games, outdoor pursuits, waterfront activities, and time spent in nature.
-  **SpEad:** Sports Leadership includes a variety of sports skill-building as well as practice being a team leader.
-  **Splash:** Swimming, Paddling, Leadership, safety, and health in and around the water with a trip to the ocean for a surf lesson.
-  **StART:** Success through Art is a focus on visual arts with individual and group projects to display at an Art Show for all campers at the end of the session.
-  **STEM:** Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math are the focus with projects that include building, exploration, nature and a trip to IDEXX, a world leader in pet health.
-  **Explore:** Exploration and Outdoor Recreation includes adventure-based activities like Mountain Biking, Archery, Canoeing, and Hiking with a nearby overnight trip.
-  **OWLS:** Outdoor & Wilderness Leadership Skills includes hiking, campfire building and cooking, nature exploration, fort building and a nearby overnight trip.
